Street parking is available, both metered and non-metered. Garage Parking is available at two city garages, each 3 blocks away.

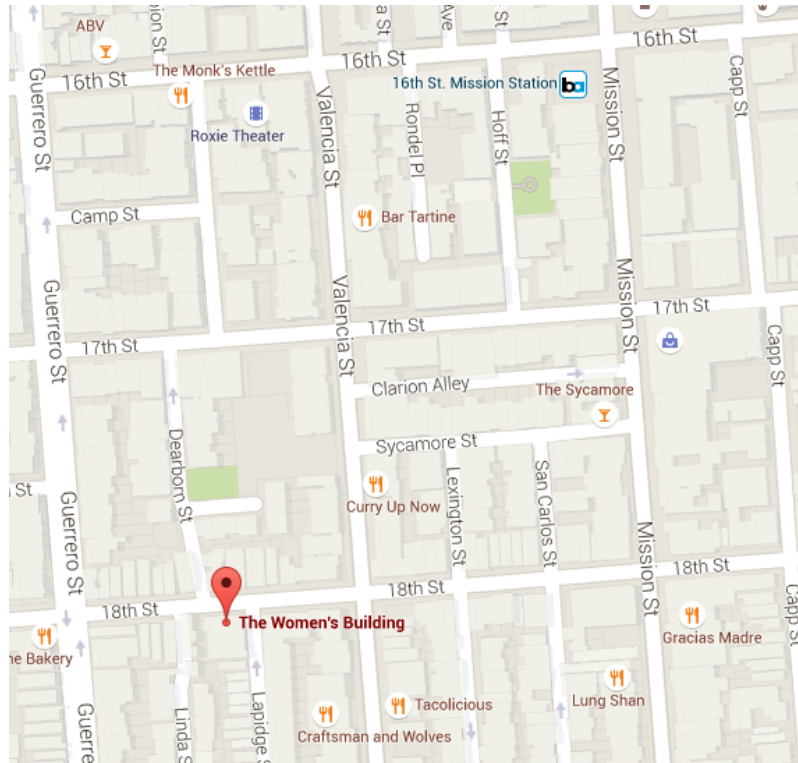
